

CLASS TRIP EXPECTATIONS AND OBLIGATIONS

The fifth grade will travel to The Henry Ford Museum and Greenfield Village on October 20-21, 2011. The goal of this trip is to provide an educational opportunity and a chance for the students to bond as a group. In order to make the trip safe and enjoyable for everyone, we ask that each student and that student's parent(s) or guardian(s) review and sign this form, which clarifies behavior guidelines.

If a student violates any of these expectations and obligations, he or she may be sent home at the sole discretion of the chaperones. In such cases, a parent or guardian will be contacted to pick up the child.

The Columbus Academy promotes an atmosphere where students and chaperones support each other with genuine respect. As a student on this class trip, you are expected to demonstrate high standards of conduct and to accept personal responsibility and consequences for your actions. In order to participate, you must agree to the following:

- I will exhibit honesty, courtesy and consideration toward others, including those in my group and others with whom I come in contact, such as chaperones, bus drivers and museum staff personnel.
- I realize that all rules and regulations of The Columbus Academy are in effect during this trip.
- I realize that I represent The Columbus Academy and should conduct myself in a manner befitting an Academy student.
- I will not be involved in any way with smoking, alcohol, drugs, vandalism, theft or any type of behavior that is detrimental to the health, well-being, safety or reputation of myself, anyone else in the group or The Columbus Academy.
- I will stay with my group unless previous arrangements have been made with my chaperone. I will not leave the museum, dormitory or any other location visited by the group unless accompanied by a chaperone.
- I will leave dormitory facilities in the same or better condition than I found them.
- I will practice common sense, respect and consideration for others and their property throughout the trip.
