Dear Class of 2018 Parents and Guardians,

We are looking ahead to an exciting 6th grade experience with your children. The 6th grade class will travel to Mohican Outdoor School on Thursday, September 15, 2011, for a two-day, one-night class trip returning to CA by 2:00 p.m. on Friday, September 16. Students may be picked up at that time, or they may take their usual way home at the end of the school day.

Mohican Outdoor School is about an hour north of Columbus near Butler, in Richland County. The Mohican Outdoor School staff will lead us in many team-building experiences. The seven advisors for Grade 6 will accompany the students on the trip. Mohican Outdoor School (www.mohicanoutdoorschool.org) is a recognized leader in environmental education.

The cost of the trip, priced at \$110 per student, includes transportation, accommodations and four meals at camp. The charge will be billed through the Business Office on the appropriate statement time. Funds are available through Ms. Long if this experience would be a financial hardship at this time.

Members of the Mohican Outdoor School staff will meet with parents and students on September 7, one week prior to the trip. Students will meet with the staff during their afternoon classes. The staff will remain on campus until the evening Middle School Parent Night to meet with parents at 6:30 p.m. prior to the Parent Night events scheduled at 7:00 p.m.
