This opportunity is offered to all student-athletes enrolled at CA entering grades 7 thru 12 in the 2011 – 2012 academic year. **All student-athletes must have BOTH their on-line Medical/Travel Release form & physical form (PPE) completed and on file at Columbus Academy PRIOR to attending the first practice.** The Medical/Travel Release form has 3 sections for you to complete or review on line: Emergency Medical Authorization, Health History, & Over-the-Counter Medication Authorization. Blank PPE forms are available on the CA intranet (Athletic Health Forms), on the OHSAA web site, in the Athletic Department, Athletic Training Room, and Dining Hall on the evening of the exams. Pages 1, 3 & 4 of the PPE form need to be completed and signed by a parent/guardian **PRIOR** to the exam, giving the physician permission to evaluate the student-athlete. Turn in all completed PPE forms to the Athletic Dept. Completed forms are valid for one calendar year from the exam date. Please note that *this is only a sports screening exam.
